Booking Process	A free visit for one teacher is permitted to carry out any school based risk assessments prior to the visit date, please note this is for one teacher per class only.
	Please consider your teacher to children ratio to help manage the visit whilst at Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth, we advise 1 adult to 6 children.
	At the time of booking a predefined schedule will have been agreed, this includes arrival times, talk times, lunch times if applicable, shop time and a departure time; please adhere to these times to ensure the visit goes swimmingly!
Before Setting Off	If any school teacher, accompanying adult or child is feeling unwell or has any of the following COVID-19 symptoms: a fever, a new and persistent cough or a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste, we reccomend they do not travel to Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth or enter the building.
Arrival at the Aquarium	There is limited coach parking in the D-Day Museum Car Park to the East of the Aquarium. There is also on street parking suitable for cars and small mini buses, a large bus stop right outside the aquarium entrance can be used for dropping off. Please note that all car parking in the area is operated by Portsmouth City Council and has no affiliation with Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth, please ensure you follow all 'pay and display' instructions.
	Once you have arrived please keep the group together outside the main entrance doors to the aquarium, one lead teacher should approach the reception desk and let the team know you have arrived. Your group will be processed and payment taken at this time, you will be given an itinerary on arrival, please ensure the timings are adhered to at all times.

Arrival at the Aquarium	Payment will be processed upon arrival, there is no option to pay after the visit. Full payment must be made on the day, we accept cash, card payments and school cheques. Unfortunately if payment is not made by the time the group arrives then they will not be admitted to the aquarium.
Bags and coats	All school bags and coats should be stored in our buggy park area, please note staff cannot handle any personal belongings. Please ensure coats and bags do not become trip hazards if left on the floor.
	All personal belongings are left at the owner's risk.
	Depending on your arrangement you may have an itinerary that requires your group to be split into separate/smaller groups; this will be explained to you at the time of your booking. We recommend smaller groups for looking around the displays, we advise the ratio of 1 adult to 6 children.
Inside the Aquarium	Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth is a free flow attraction, with a reccomended one way route throughout the exhibits; this should be followed at all times.
	Please be conscious of other guests using the Aquarium and maintain social distancing wherever possible to limit contact with members of the public, ensure the group is supervised at all times and are aware of keeping a safe distance from other Aquarium Users.
	All members of the public will be informed that there is a group booking within the Aquarium upon arrival.
	It is important that all members of the group limit touching any surfaces such as tank ledges, tank glass, benches etc.
	Please ensure each group waits until the area ahead of them is clear of other visitors before moving into it . This will help minimise crowding.
Play Area	Please ensure the group is supervised when making use of the outside play area. This is an outside area and as such is open to the elements. In fine weather there is a splash play area. Please ensure children are dressed appropriatelty should you choose to make use of this area.

Lunch Facilities	If you are visiting during May, June or July please be aware that there is no inside space available for lunches.
	If you are visiting us between September and April there may be a room available for lunch but this must be reserved at time of booking.
Shop Time	At the time of booking a predefined time will have been agreed for the group to use the gift shop, please ensure these timings are followed.
	Please keep in your agreed smaller groups, we advise 1 adults to 6 children, when using the shop, groups visiting the gift shop should not exceed 10 children.
	Please be aware of other shop users, please keep the group together where ever possible and maintain a safe distance from others.
	Cash can be accepted and alternatively we can offer souvenir/goody bags to suit most budgets should this be a better option for your group, this will remove the need to use the gift shop, minimising contact with others.
	Souvenir packs must be pre-ordered at least 48 hours before the visit is due to commence.
Lost Children	Please ensure the group is kept together at all times and supervised by an adult.
	Before arriving at the Aquarium, please make it known to the group that should anyone become separated they should head back to the reception desk and inform a staff member.
	If a child gets separated from the group, please inform a staff member immediately, all staff members carry radios and they will alert the management team to take action.

First Aid	As part of the site team there will always be at least one fully trained first aider on duty. However in order to minimise contact
	issues and mixing of groups we do reccomend visiting groups also have a trained first aider among the party.
	The first aider can be contacted from our reception point where we keep a fully stocked first aid box. Please note we are unable to issue medication of any kind.
	Staff will be wearing PPE and a self- help approach may be adopted for lesser injuries, the first aider will talk the adult through administering first aid .
	For all accidents and incidents the accident book must be completed, please be aware this process can take time to complete, but as part of our Health & Safety policy this is unavoidable.
	The nearest hospital with Accident & Emergency facilities is Queen Alexandra Hospital, Southwick Hill Road, Cosham, Portsmouth, Hampshire, PO6 3LY approximately 6.3 miles from Blue Reef Aquarium Portmouth.
Accessibility	Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth is fully accessible for wheelchair users and visitors with walking difficulties.
Unruly Children	Please ensure all children are well behaved for the benefit of all our guests and staff,
	Children should be supervised by an adult at all times.
	Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth staff will instruct children to behave where necessary, especially if this behaviour could lead to an incident or accident.
Weather Protection	The main Aquarium is indoors, however our Beach Club and Play Area are outside, please ensure that sun protection and/or wet weather clothes have been considered before arriving at Blue Reef Aquarium. Portsmouth
Slips, Trips and Falls	There can from time to time be surface water on the floor in the Aquarium due to fish splashing, if you observe this please inform a member of staff.
	There should be no running around the Aquarium; children should be supervised by an adult at all times.

Open Top Tanks and Displays	There are display tanks at different heights around the Aquarium, please ensure group members do not at any time put hands in any of the tanks or attempt to touch any of the fish. Visitors must wash their hands if they have come into contact with any creatures or water. There should be no climbing or pushing to see the exhibits, please take your time when around water. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
	Should the fire alarm sound, please lead the group through the nearest fire exit; please remember this could be behind you.
Fire Safety and Evacuation	The Fire Assembly Point is outside the front of the aquarium building or at the rear of the building next to the sand pits. A member of staff will be dispatched to liase with your group,.
·····	Please keep calm and act swiftly.
	The fire alarm is monitored so may be supported by the Fire Brigade in some instances including false alarms.
	The Blue Reef Aquarium Portsmouth team are fully trained in Fire Evacuation and Emergency Procedures
Exit and leaving the site	Exiting the Aquarium displays is through the shop; this is part of the one way route and should be followed at all times.
	Please ensure you have all belongings with you before leaving the Aquarium.
